



## **The results are in!**

Thank you for taking part in our annual NAEYC Family Survey. We always use your feedback to reflect and set goals within our program. The 26 questions you answered translate out into 71 criteria we must meet regarding the family criteria for our NAEYC accreditation!

### **Highlights:**

- \*100% of you agree to having a good relationship with your child's teacher and other staff members. These partnerships are invaluable to us as we work with you in helping your child grow and learn.
- \*100% of families are welcome and invited to take part in classroom activities and events and we love to have your help and support!
- \*100% report being comfortable with what your child is learning, how your child's progress is measured, that you have opportunities to discuss what is learned and how we measure their progress.
- \*96% believe the staff work with you to meet your child's individual or special needs and helps you get other resources within the community when needed.

### **Goals to continue to improve upon:**

\*\*\*8 of 34 families answered "Don't Know" regarding how we help you get to know other families in the program and encourage you to support each other. Having been in our new building and community for a year now we have marched with families in the 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade, sat together on the front retaining wall to cheer on the Arrowhead Homecoming parade, done business Trick-or-Treat with center families meeting at the center and walking together and enjoyed the Hartland Lights in December in addition to the family nights we host during the year in the center. Please watch for signs by the entrances regarding these events and join us! They are fun, casual, family events where you, as parents, can really get to know other families within the center.

\*\*\*83% feel welcome and invited to participate by helping to plan events, being involved in decisions about the program and taking on leadership roles. We realize your children are in our care because you have to work outside of the home but we always welcome your feedback to help us in making the best decisions for the center and your children. If anyone would ever like to help with the planning of our family nights, our Week of the Young Child activities in April please let Jane know.

At the classroom level, teachers will ask families to bring in different items for parties or special activities and to participate with us. Due to the high number of part-time attendance schedules, you are always welcome to meet us out at a field trip location with your child or come in to join special classroom activities with your child.
