Why choose Grandma's House 4K Program?

*We offer your child a full-day 4K program with certified teachers in a familiar and comfortable environment.

*Our class sizes are limited to 14 children with one teacher to allow for one-on-one and small group instruction. An assistant teacher will be added if enrollment exceeds 14 children.

*We have a strong literacy emphasis to teach language & writing readiness skills.

*Our math instruction involves hands-on activities with manipulatives along with worksheets to



introduce number value, make one-to-one correspondence connections and to write numerals.

*Each classroom is equipped with computers that provide enrichment programs for math, science, social studies and literacy.

*Science is explored through hands-on experiments and units.

*Social studies units include field trips out into the community.



*Art and music activities are included daily in the curriculum to expose your child to various media and cultural avenues.

*Child evaluations are completed three times during the school year based on Child Portfolio collections along with Parent-Teacher conferences.

Which centers offer a Kindergarten Program?

Junior (4K) classes are offered at all of the Grandma's House Centers. However, a minimum enrollment of 10 children is required for each class. There is a 4 day/week requirement. (All are welcome to attend Monday-Friday, but Fridays will be an enrichment day for those who attend.)

Who should enroll?

All children turning 4 by September 1, 2010.
